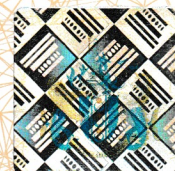

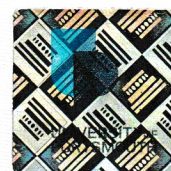

Degree – Awarding Powers (DAP) and University Title (UT)

University of Portsmouth has taught and research degree awarding powers and university title. This status was granted by Act of Parliament in 1992 and is maintained through the university's ongoing compliance with i) the conditions of registration set by the sector regulator, The Office for students and ii) adherence to the core and common practices defined by the sector's designated quality assurance body, The Quality Assurance agency.

Taught degree-awarding powers (TDAP) give UK higher education providers the right to award bachelor's degrees with honours and other taught higher education qualification up to levels 6/7 of The Framework for Higher Education Qualifications in England, Wales and Research degree-awarding powers give UK higher education providers with TDAP the right to award doctoral degrees and master's degrees where the research component (including a requirement to produce original work) is larger than the taught component when measured by student effort. These are higher education qualifications up to the levels 7/8 of the Framework for Higher Education Qualifications in England, Wales and Northern Ireland, and up to levels 11/12 in the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework.

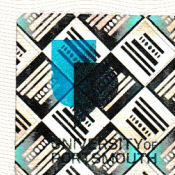


